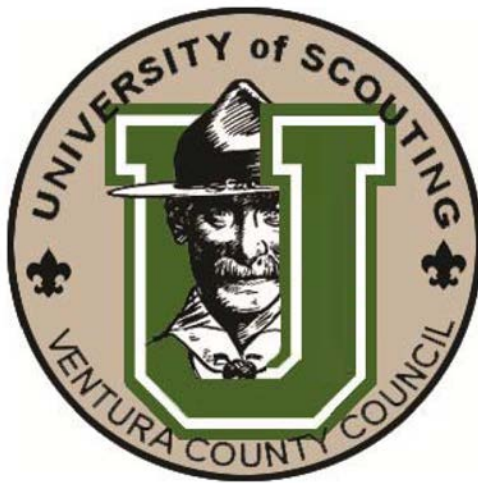

EARN YOUR CYBER CHIP



AT THE 2018 VCC UNIVERSITY OF SCOUTING!

In addition to being a rank requirement for certain Cub Scout and Boy Scout ranks, the Cyber Chip can be used as a tool to show skill and a commitment to do what's right in the cyber world. Many unit leaders use the Cyber Chip before allowing any electronic use on outings—this is a decision each unit can make on its own, much like the Totin' Chip is used today.

One of the requirements for the Cyber Chip (Boy Scout level) is:

“Write and sign a personalized contract with your parent or guardian that outlines rules for using the computer and mobile devices, including what you can download, what you can post, and consequences for inappropriate use.”










If this is done in advance, and presented at the course, all the rest of the requirements can be completed during the course and you can walk out with your Cyber Chip!

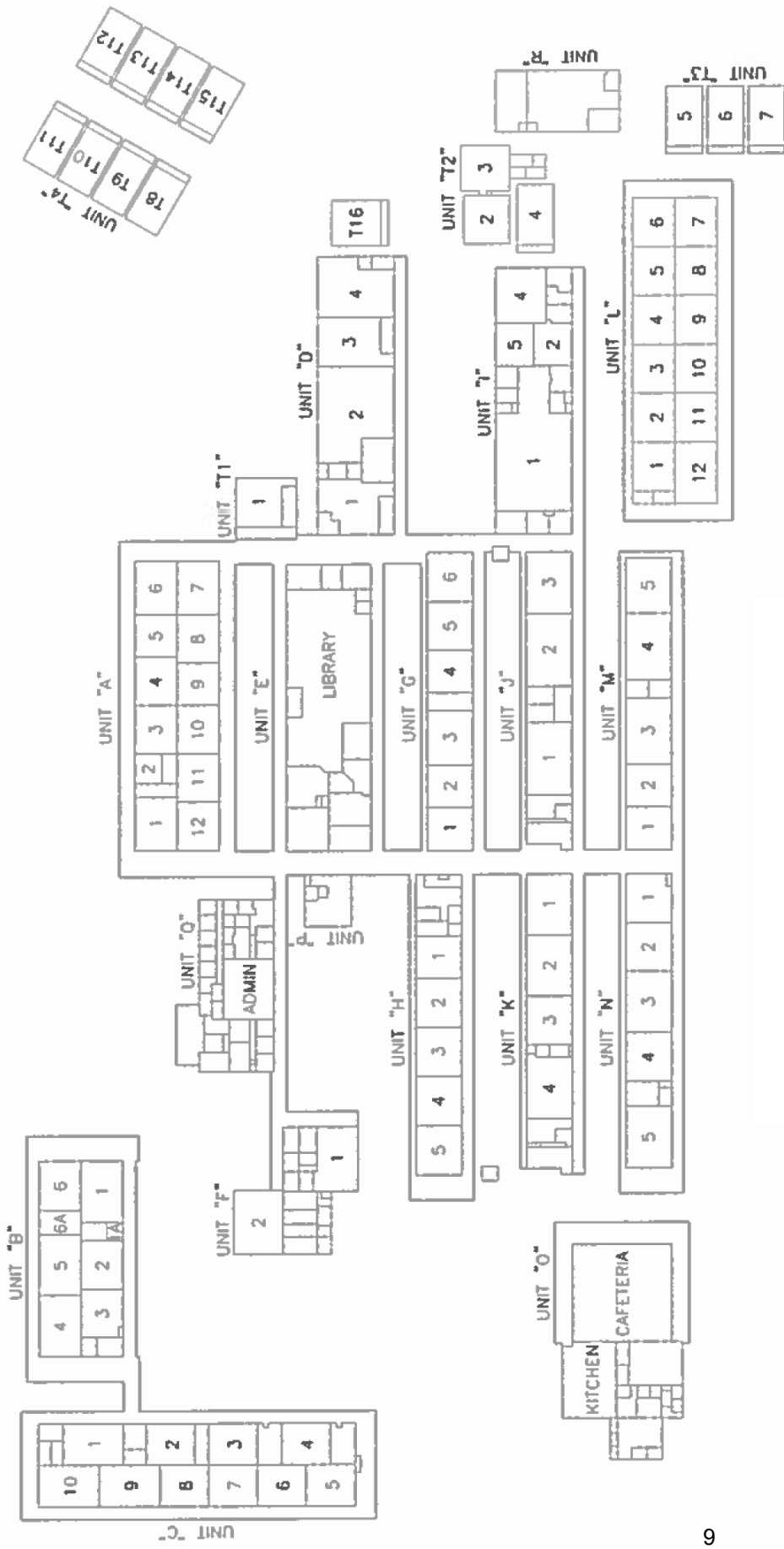

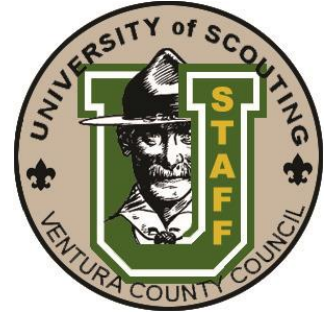
