*Directions to Camp Willett: On Hwy 33 must north of Casitas Springs, turn onto Sulphur Mountain Road, and drive 1/3-mile to a gate. From there drive 4 miles (slowly!) on a dirt road until you see a big yellow sign that says "Camp Willett". Turn left and go down a mile until you get to camp. Drive carefully—there are bikers and hikers on the road. (It takes 25 minutes on dirt roads!)
